**Inspection details** A growing season inspection was carried out on this 2010 research and development potato trial. The inspection included checks on isolation from related crops, the layout and dimensions of the trial, arrangements for restricting human access to the site, the planting of the crop and the proposed harvesting arrangements.

The layout of the trial and operational arrangements were in accordance with the consent conditions. The nearest related crop (potatoes) was in excess of the 20 metres stipulated in the consent conditions.

In addition to the field inspection visit an audit was carried out to check the detailed arrangements in place for monitoring and management of the trial.

**Report conclusions** The GM Inspectorate is content that the release is consistent with the conditions of the consent and did not identify any risks to human health or the environment posed by the genetically modified organism.
