Inspection details A growing season inspection was carried out on this 2008 Research and Development potato trial, managed under consent 06/R42/01.

The inspection visit included checks on the size and layout of the trial, isolation from related crops, measures for restricting human access to the site, operational procedures, record keeping and arrangements for transport/storage of material.

The trial area, the layout of the trial and operational arrangements were in accordance with the consent conditions, as were measures for restricting access, operational procedures and arrangements transport/storage of material. The trial site was surrounded by cereal crops and a fallow area. The nearest potatoes remain approximately 300m from the trial site.

The release was found to be consistent with the consent conditions.

Report conclusions The GM Inspectorate is content that the release is consistent with the conditions of the consent and did not identify any risks to human health or the environment posed by the GMO.
